Synopsis

Orozimba and the Oboe is a fantastical story about a girl that was orphaned by her mother and who sets out with her pet vulture Mimi on an adventure to save the local mangrove and her father from the clutches of the sinister Faustino. Along the way, Orozimba connects with her African and Indigenous roots and discovers her own magic powers: she beholds the power of music – when she plays the oboe (that belonged to her mother), she is able to communicate with plants and animals, bewitching them into doing good.

But the oboe disappears, and she is willing to do whatever it takes to get it back. Cunning and intelligent, she reveals the mysteries of the natural world and begins to staunchly defend the forest.
